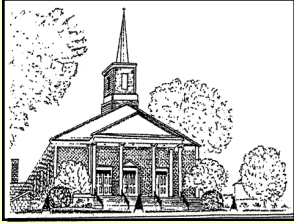

A Note From Our Pastor



My Dear Parishioners,

We have another appearance of the Risen Christ. In each of Jesus' Resurrection appearances, He reveals Himself to a disciple or an apostle and then instructs that person to go tell others that He is risen. Through these appearances, the Lord is taking this group of disciples, broken apart and scattered by His crucifixion and death, and is reweaving them together around the truth of His Resurrection.

In the appearance recounted in the Gospel reading, the Lord establishes the features that will be part of every authentic Christian community until the end of time: His peace, His presence and His purpose. He appears to the Apostles and His first words are "Peace be with you." He gives them His peace because they were in turmoil, confusion and guilt. These "followers" had abandoned Him and denied Him despite their strong claims that they would do otherwise. They knew that they betrayed their Master. They were sorry but they couldn't turn back the clock. Jesus knows of their repentance. He comes now and says, "Peace be with you" to let them know that they were forgiven. That was why their fear turned to joy. They were forgiven!

This is the message of Jesus at every Mass today and in all our sacraments. It is the message of forgiveness that comes with repentance. Forgiveness and repentance go together. Unfortunately, people try to separate them. Some people love repentance and do it all the time but do not really believe that there is forgiveness for them. Others want forgiveness but without repentance. But put them together and we have a wonderful Easter truth. No matter what we may have done, whatever our past, however horrible the things we did, our repentance can bring new life, healing, forgiveness, and peace. We can become a new creation.

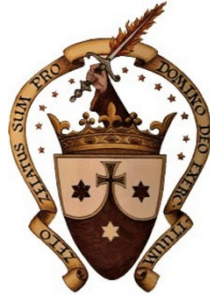

THE SECOND SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

V. Praised be Jesus Christ...

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, today is referred to as *Bone Pastor* [Good Shepherd] Sunday, named so after the Gospel account. Our Lord addresses the Pharisees, stating that He is the Good Shepherd who has willingness to lay down His life for the sheep. Jesus underscores that He lays down His life for those who belong to Him. He calls all of humanity, bidding all to hear His voice and come into the fold. The hireling flees at the first sign of trouble, and one wonders if Jesus did not want the Pharisees to see themselves in this. In our troubled times, there are still some in religious authority who seek interests other than the best interests of the sheep. And this is why people such as these need prayer. The Epistle of today, too, gives us a good look at the value of suffering and the accountability of the Christian life.

We Carmelites listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd. The world presents us with many hirelings and even some false shepherds. The attachments to the world and to worldly things can also lure the sheep away – so, we must guard our hearts. The more we give our risen Lord our all, the more we possess Him and we conform ourselves to the fruit of what He did for us.

To Jesus Christ, truly victorious over sin and death, be all glory forever, alleluia!
