



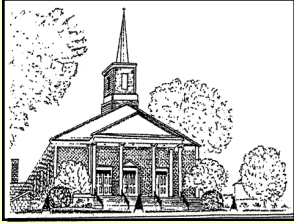

### A Note From Our Pastor



My Dear Parishioners,

During this forty-day period between Easter and the Ascension of Our Lord, the Church asks us to keep our eyes on Heaven, our final dwelling place, to which Our Lord is calling us. This invitation becomes more pressing as we approach the day on which Jesus went up to the right hand of his Father. Our Lord had promised his disciples that in a little while he would be with them forever. Yet a little while, and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Our Lord has kept His promise in this period when He stays close to His loved ones. But this presence will not end when He goes up with His glorious body to His Father, because, by His Passion and Death He has prepared for us a place in His Father's house, where there are many mansions. 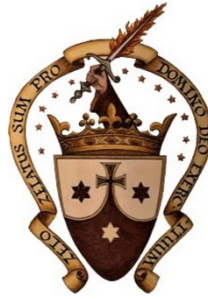

## The Carmelite Corner

### THE FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

∇. Praised be Jesus Christ... R̄. Now and forever!

*Vocem jucunditatis annuntiáte,  
et audiátur. allelúja:  
annuntiáte usque ad extrémum terrae:  
liberávit Dóminus pópulum suum:  
Allelúja, allelúja.*

**Declare it with a voice of joy  
and make it known, alleluia:  
Declare it to the ends of the earth:  
The Lord hath delivered His people:  
Alleluia, alleluia. [Is 48:20]**

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, the Easter season is winding down, but Mass begins with an allusion to Isaiah, an Old Testament prefigurement of the glory of the triumph over death by Jesus. Once again, we rejoice with Ps. 65, announcing to the “ends of the earth” that Jesus is risen from the dead, smashing the power of sin over our lives.

The Epistle of today is a continuation of James. We are admonished not simply to abide in religious fervor, or simply to feel “good” about what Jesus has done for us. We are admonished to be Christians of action, and not only by word. It is likened to someone who has good health but poor memory – we enjoyed a good “look” at ourselves, but then forgot how we appear. If we are to have a good Christian “memory,” we must put into practice all that the Master has directed us – we will lose what we have been “given” if we do not “give it away.” So, let us follow this message to sacrifice for the good of others, for this leads to our cooperation in fulfilling the righteousness of God. The Gospel of today sees Jesus promising that the disciples would receive what they ask in His name – this points particularly to things that point to those things that would make their “joy [to] be full.” Not necessarily for that new sports car, but that which has eternal value. All of His ministry, Jesus taught in parables and proverbs. He did this to challenge those who truly wished to be disciples – they needed to figure this stuff out. But now, John’s Gospel shows that Jesus does not risk having His message lost – He speaks plainly, and the disciples realize it. Jesus prepares the disciples for His return to the Father; He is risen in His glorified body, first-fruits of a pledge of glory for us.

The Carmelite devotes much attention to the Resurrection of the Lord. The daily encounter with the Risen Lord is a principal influence on our spirituality. This focus draws the Carmelite into a reciprocal love of the Risen One with ourselves. In the Eucharist on the day of Resurrection, we identify with the love and overwhelming joy of Mary Magdalene on that glorious morning.

To Jesus Christ be all glory, alleluia!

*“From the moment I entered religious life, I considered God
